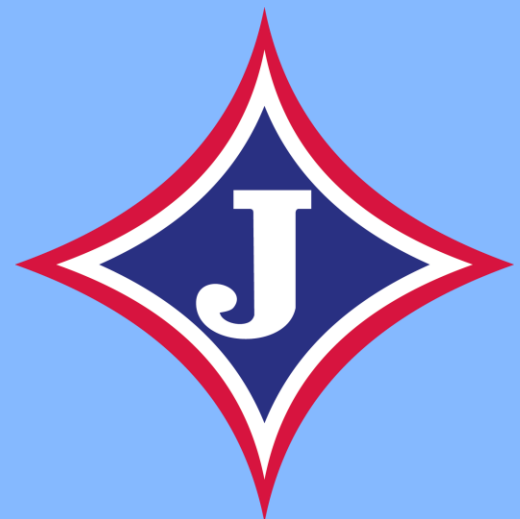
2007 – 2015 Post-Graduate Data
