# What IS the Youth Apprenticeship Program?



- Students work during part of the school day in a job that matches with a career that they want to pursue
- Students learn content in the classroom and get experience on the jobsite
- Students get academic credit and a paycheck!





# *Who can be in the Youth Apprenticeship Program?*

- students who are age 16 or older and in the 11th grade or 12<sup>th</sup> grade
- students who have taken at least one course in their chosen career field or pathway
- students who are on track to graduate and are not failing their core subjects (Even though you are in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade, **PLAN NOW** and **PASS YOUR CLASSES** so that you can have this as an option later!)
- students who are responsible, hard-working, and reliable
